documents the improbable role of beatles music in the downfall of the soviet union tracing the progress of bootleg recordings and illegal broadcasts that inspired soviet youth to abandon decades of official culture and authoritarianism

empathy is the currency of all music and joe mulhall does a great job of explaining how that quality has been used to generate solidarity for the struggle and sympathy for those who suffer injustice billy bragg a beautiful account of how music has unified healed and inspired humanity during some of history s darkest days illuminating uplifting and important james o brien while the global history of the dictatorships oppression racism and state violence over the last century is well known the role that music played in people s lives during these times is less understood this book is a collection of stories and hidden histories about how music provided light in the darkest of times over the past century how it steeled souls and inspired resistance to oppression rebel sounds will explore freedom songs in the republic of ireland the soviet union s oppression behind the berlin wall authoritarian dictatorships in brazil and nigeria institutionalised racism and police violence in america and south africa street violence in britain ethnic cleansing in the balkans and musical resistance in war torn ukraine this is a social history of the twentieth century but one that takes in the human impulse to create share and enjoy the one thing that connects cultures and spans generations music

have western exegetes turned an eastern book into a western one has our fondness for a fixed printed text capable of being analyzed with precision and exactitude blinded us to other hermeneutic possibilities does god require all people to be able to analyze grammar to interpret scripture does god assume all people can interpret scripture through oral means the authors recognize the effects of centuries of literacy socialization that produced a blind spot in the western christian world the neglect by most in the academies agencies and assemblies of the foundational and forceful role orality had on the biblical text and

teaching from the inspired spoken word of the prophets including jesus pre text to the elite literate scribes who painstakingly hand printed the sacred text to post text interpretation and teaching the footprint of orality throughout the entire process is acutely visible to those having the oral aural influenced eyes of the mediterranean ancients could oral hermeneutics be the mother of relational theology

music and democracy explores music as a resource for societal transformation processes this book provides recent insights into how individuals and groups used and still use music to achieve social cultural and political participation and bring about social change the contributors present outstanding perspectives on the topic from the promise and myth of democratization through music technology to the use of music in imposing authoritarian neoliberal or even fascist political ideas in the past and present up to music s impact on political systems governmental representation and socio political realities the volume further features approaches in the fields of gender migration disability and digitalization

dmitrii shepilov 1905 1995 a prominent soviet leader and member of the communist party elite rose to power under joseph stalin in the 1940s and 1950s then fell into political disgrace after being implicated in a coup attempt against nikita khrushchev in 1957 in this remarkable memoir shepilov provides an unparalleled account of soviet politics during this period as well as first hand recollections of prominent political leaders including stalin khrushchev mao zedong lavrentii beria andrei zhdanov and others secretary of the central committee editor in chief of pravda and director of the communist party s bureau of propaganda and agitation shepilov tells his story from the perspective of a true insider his memoir sheds new light on soviet relations with china the aborted coup against khrushchev the personal rivalries that drove high level soviet politics and much more his report dramatic opinionated and engaging is an important addition to the history of his sparsely documented era

an illustrated study of the history of the moscow kremlin a metaphor for russia a symbol for its government and an enduring icon of the country a fortified complex covering 70 acres at the heart of moscow behind walls up to 18m high and watched over by 20 towers the kremlin houses everything from russia s seat of political power to glittering churches this is a fortress that has evolved over time from the original wooden guard tower built in the 11th century to the current stone and brick complex over the years having been built burnt besieged and rebuilt starting with the initial building of a wooden watch tower on the banks of the moskva river in the 11th century this book follows the kremlin s tumultuous

history through rises and falls and various iterations to today supported by photographs specially commissioned artwork and maps in the process it tells a story of russia and also unveils a range of mysteries around the fortress from the 14th century underground tunnels built to permit spies to enter and leave it covertly through to today s invisible defences such as it gps spoofing field switch on your phone inside the walls and it may well tell you you re at vnukovo airport 30km away and drone jammers

russian counterintelligence chief colonel dominika egorova has been an asset of the cia for over seven years she has also been in a forbidden and tumultuous love affair with her handler nate nash mortally dangerous for them both but irresistible in washington a newly installed administration is selecting its cabinet members dominika hears whispers of a russian operation to place a mole in a high intelligence position if the candidate is confirmed the kremlin will have access to the identities of cia assets in moscow including dominika dominika recklessly immerses herself in the palace intrigues of the kremlin searching for the mole s identity and stealing secrets before her time runs out
