6 000 people killed while walking in america in 2018 in the last ten years there has been a 50 percent increase in pedestrian deaths the tragedy of traffic violence has barely registered with the media and wider culture disproportionately the victims are like duarte rodriguez immigrants the poor and people of color they have largely been blamed and forgotten in right of way journalist angie schmitt shows us that deaths like duarte rodriquez s are not unavoidable accidents they don't happen because of jaywalking or distracted walking they are predictable occurring in stark geographic patterns that tell a story about systemic inequality these deaths are the forgotten faces of an increasingly urgent public health crisis that we have the tools but not the will to solve schmitt examines the possible causes of the increase in pedestrian deaths as well as programs and movements that are beginning to respond to the epidemic her investigation unveils why pedestrians are dying and she demands action right of way is a call to reframe the problem acknowledge the role of racism and classism in the public response to these deaths and energize advocacy around road safety ultimately schmitt argues that we need improvements in infrastructure and changes to policy to save lives right of way unveils a crisis that is rooted in both inequality and the undeterred reign of the automobile in our cities it challenges us to imagine and demand safer and more equitable cities where no one is expendable
